Readers Special School Red Leather Cricket Ball – 4.75oz Youths size



Readers make very good quality cricket balls, and this one, (whilst relatively inexpensive) is still a good quality purchase. Yes - it IS the least expensive ball that we sell, but it is NOT a “bottom of the range” ball. (Many manufacturers and retailers do sell bottom of the range balls – but we don't!)
Jon reckons that this ball “does the job it needs to do” for juniors who want to own a leather practice cricket ball.

Non Leather practice balls (same weight & size as Leather cricket balls)

Readers Playground Pudding Ball - Red - Available in Junior size and Adult size



Please do not be put off by the slightly silly name of this ball, this is a BRILLIANT BALL TO OWN & USE. It is **exactly the same size & weight as a leather cricket ball**, but it's made of a moulded rubber type material, so it's safer to use for practice.

This is the main type of "non leather" ball that Jon now uses in his coaching sessions....and here's why.....

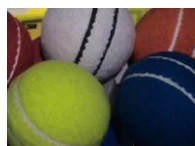
1. These balls are exactly the same size as a leather cricket ball.
2. These balls are exactly the same weight as a leather cricket ball (You may not know, but most other practice balls are lighter than real leather balls which can create problems. This is the ONLY one we have found which is an absolutely identical weight.
3. It is near on impossible to wear these balls out. Yes the colour does go a bit duller after time - but we have never seen one of these Playground Pudding balls split (which is something we know is a real problem with some other brands of practice balls.
4. These Playground Pudding balls are less expensive to buy than most other practice balls.
Available in 2 sizes: junior and adult.

Readers "All Play" ball (Heavyweight, low bounce with seam.)



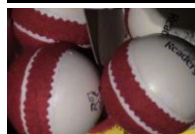
Whilst these look a bit like tennis balls, they really aren't that similar when you put a tennis ball & one of these side by side. The first difference is that All Play balls are manufactured by to be **heavier** in weight than a traditional tennis ball. This means that an all play ball has a more **"cricket-ball-like-bounce"** than a tennis ball has. (Tennis balls can often be a bit too "bouncy" for playing & practicing cricket)

The All Play ball also has **seam markings**, to assist players to in ensuring their technique is correct.

Readers "Swinger" ball

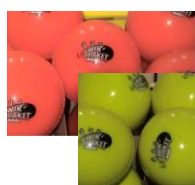

- These are **BRIGHT PINK!** (whereas Kwik Cricket balls are orange or yellow)

These are NOT just pink as a gimmick - we're told your eyes can pick up the colour pink really easily, so that's why these have been made.
